



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Use crayons or markers to color in the mask.
- 2 Cut out mask along outer black lines.
- 3 Carefully cut out eyeholes where designated with an "X".
- 4 Cut away more paper to make larger eyes if needed.
- 5 Cut out small "x" holes. Tie one piece of elastic string, yarn, or ribbon to each hole on side of mask.
- 6 Tie behind head to secure.
