INSTRUCTIONS: THOMPSON EDUCATION ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. To be eligible for the TEA Scholarship, one parent or guardian <u>MUST</u> be a full member of TEA/TESPA. This is a one-time scholarship available to incoming freshmen only.
- 2. Complete the scholarship **application** carefully. Supply all the information requested because <u>incomplete applications will not be considered</u>.
- 3. Prepare a **personal letter** addressing your Career and Academic Plan. This letter is to accompany your application form. The letter should include:
 - a. Information that was not adequately explained in the application form,
 - b. Reasons why you plan to continue your education beyond high school,
 - c. Your ambitions and career goals, and
 - d. Reasons why you feel you merit consideration for this Thompson Education Association scholarship award.
- 4. Request a **transcript** from your counselor which is to be included in your scholarship application.
- 5. Submit three (3) letters of recommendation. They may include educational staff, coach/sponsor, employer or former employer, a neighbor, a minister or priest, a professional person such as a doctor. In any case, the individuals from whom you request these letters of recommendation should know you well. These letters must come directly from the source to the committee chairperson (currently william.sherman@tsd.org). For example, from the counselor/coach to the chair. Recommendation letters may not come from the student or family members of the student.
- 6. Email your application, transcript, letters of recommendation, and your personal letter addressing your career plan to: (scanned documents are fine) We are not accepting paper applications, recommendations, or letters.

7. Application packets <u>MUST</u> be completed and on file by <u>Monday</u>, <u>April 15th</u>, <u>2024</u> (end of work day). This deadline must be observed if you wish to be considered for this scholarship.
